Looking for Camp Shelanu Staff

Dedicated, fun, creative, senior camp staff needed! Camp Shelanu of Congregation B'nai Israel (Sacramento, CA) is looking to staff our summer day camp program. If you like to play, sing, create, and laugh with campers ages 5 to 15, we want you to be part of Camp Shelanu.

Our camp calendar consists of four specialty sessions of one week each. Camp dates are July 9 through August 3 with staff training occurring the first week of July.

Camp Director: Must have extensive camp background, work experience with children, supervisory experience, and a knowledge of Jewish culture, Jewish tradition, and Jewish history. Director is responsible for the supervision and welfare of both campers and staff and will act as a general resource for all camp and staff programming needs. Working as a team with the Director of Education, Camp Director is responsible for theme development, staff training, program planning, and supply purchasing. Start date: mid-April (in terms of planning and need not be on-site until early June). Salary Range: \$4,000-\$5,000.

Senior Camp Counselors: Must be at least 18 and have camp or related experience. Each senior counselor has direct responsibility for a group of campers, for the supervision of a junior counselor and a C.I.T. Responsibilities include planning and implementation of group activities. Working knowledge of Jewish culture and tradition strongly preferred. Prospective applicants must be enthusiastic and be responsible when working with both peers and campers. Salary range: \$1300 - \$1500

Junior Camp Counselors: Under the leadership of a Sr. Counselor, plan and lead activities for groups of campers. Model leadership for C.I.T.s assigned to group. Must be entering 11th or 12th grade. Camp experience strongly preferred, must have experience working with kids. Salary range: \$800 - \$1000

Counselors in Training (CIT): Under the leadership of a Sr. or Jr. Counselor, assist with activities for groups of campers. Participate in counselor training program and develop leadership skills. Must be entering 9th or 10th grade, with strong interest in working with kids. Must be enthusiastic and responsible, and must be able to work as part of a team. CITs earn certificate of completion, Red Cross CPR/First Aid certification and may be eligible for high school community service credit.

Child Care Worker: Must be at least 16 and available to work from 7:30am – 9am and from 4pm to 6pm, M-F. Should have experience and ability to lead age-appropriate day care activities. Rate of pay: \$8.00 per hr.
